The Year Ahead

The first day of summer is just around the corner and everything is in bloom again. This is a beautiful time of year when flowers, shrubs and yards flourish. It's also that time of year when unwanted weeds start to pop up everywhere. Controlling weeds is an easy process if you get ahead of the curve early.

Weeds that show their ugly head in your flower beds can easily be taken care of with products like Round-Up. Spray Round-up along the edges of your beds and spot control weeds every other week or so. If used sparingly it won't harm your shrubs and trees.

Keeping your yard mowed on a weekly basis will help control weeds that pop up. This helps the Bermuda Grass to grow and smother the weeds. There are also easy to apply products like Weed Stop For Yards. Plug it into the end of your hose and spray away. This will control most common weeds. Don't fret if they don't die right away, sometimes it takes a couple weeks. Another application may be needed if they don't eventually go away. Keep in mind that weeds in your yard will creep into your neighbor's yard, keeping your yard mowed weekly and free of weeds is a great way to help your neighbor.
