Currently the HOA is looking into updating some of the Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CCR's). The CCR's are a comprehensive legal document we all agreed to abide by when purchasing our homes. The main purpose of the CCR's is to ensure all of us are being good neighbors. A few of the updates the board is looking at are:

- Provision for limiting number of rental homes in the neighborhood.
- Adding fence maintenance standards.
- Removing wording prohibiting satellite dishes.
